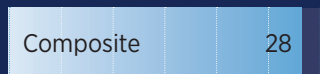

MEAN ACT SCORE

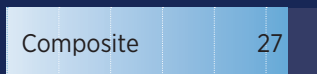


2nd Quartile: 16 students

MEAN SAT SCORE

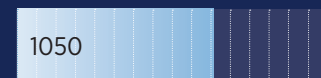


MEAN ACT SCORE

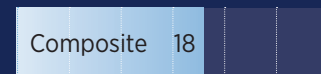
